Statement of our reasons why we sought extensions:

Reason	Work involved, but not limited to
Collect the remaining book debts (EVCL 2 and EVCL 3)	Corresponding with our advisors in order to realise available sums due to the fact that a significant proportion of the debts outstanding are subject to legitimate, contractual set-off due to contractual breaches of supply arrangements.
Recover the VAT refunds due (EVCL 1, EVCL 2 and EVCL 3)	Continuing to chase HM Revenue and Customers to ensure receipt of the VAT refund for the period ended 16 February 2024 as well as preparing a final VAT return. These additional realisations are required to be received by the estates to enable the final distributions to the preferential creditors.
Finalise the tax position (EVCL 1, EVCL 2 and EVCL 3)	Preparing the final tax returns and paying the corporation tax in relation to profits made from the interest earned on the bank accounts. Corresponding with HM Revenue and Customs in relation to the finalisation of the tax position of the Companies.
Make distributions to the first ranking and secondary ranking preferential creditors (where appropriate) (EVCL 1 and EVCL 2)	Corresponding with former employees regarding dividend and issuing preferential claim agreement forms, reviewing and adjudicating first ranking and secondary preferential creditor claims, calculating dividend rate and preparing and paying distribution to the secondary preferential creditor (where appropriate).
